TIPS

Dear Moose Lodge friends,

We are avid skiers ourselves and are happy to share our tips with you. Please feel free to share your tips with us, too. We love to learn.

We also regularly receive several standard questions. You will find the answers to the most important ones below.

APARTMENT

The address is St. Jakober Dorfstrasse 109, 6580 Sankt Anton am Arlberg.

(Near the church in the hamlet of St Jakob)

Moose Lodge consists of four luxurious flats.

There is only 1 flat per floor!

MARMOT

2 to 4 persons => 1 bedroom - ground floor street side (no terrace)

STEINBOCK

8 to 10 people => 4 bedrooms + closed bunk bed - first floor - large sun terrace

HIRSCH

8 to 10 persons => 4 bedrooms + closed bunk bed - second floor - large sun balcony

MOOSE

6 people => 3 bedrooms - third floor - large sun terrace - fireplace - wooden gable roof

DOOR CODES - PHYSICAL RECEPTION

A few days before departure you will receive via MAIL two door codes:

- 1 code for the entrance, garage and ski room (consisting of four digits)

- 1 code for the flat. (Consisting of four digits)

=> check your SPAM mail if necessary!

In case of problems, please mail info@moose-lodge.com or call the Belgian owners for urgent matters (Peter: 0032 485 249 214) - we speak Dutch, English, French and German.

So, there is NO KEY and NO physical reception.

However, someone will come afterwards to arrange the deposit, Local tax and such.

SKIBUS

St. Anton has a central bus route "Line 2" - during peak hours, a ski bus passes every 8 minutes!

Moose-Lodge is right on the central bus route; there is a bus stop at MOOSE LODGE at 100 meters left (Gsör) or 100 meters right (Kirche)

Buses run constantly back and forth, especially during 'rush hours'. Use is also free until 6.30pm. You will find timetables at the stops or under: https://www.st-anton.at/fileadmin/user_upload/linie2_VB_22.pdf

The bus ride takes about seven minutes to Nasserein or 10 minutes to Galzig (Terminal West).

This is where all of St Anton's lifts start.

At the same place, take the free bus back to Moose-Lodge: choose bus route no. 2 St Jakob.

Everywhere, you can also take a ski taxi. Expect an average of €20 for this.

Ski boot room

Moose-Lodge has its own ski room where you can place skis, poles and helmets. Heating elements are also provided for ski boots.

There is also the possibility to rent a ski depot directly at the lifts in one of the sports stores (fee required).



CATERING

KITCHEN

Each apartment has a modern and fully equipped open kitchen. All facilities for a good kitchen are present.

An induction hob, a fridge with freezer and a fully automatic coffee machine (except in the apartment MARMOT, there is a capsule machine) are available.

On foot, you can find the supermarket "MPreis" in about 10min (550m), a very good supermarket with a bakery.

In the center of St. Anton, there are other supermarkets like the Spar and the Billa.

BREAD SERVICE

In the welcome brochure, you will find the login details to order bread rolls from bakery RUETZ. Your order will be delivered early in the morning in the entrance hall.

Simply put the corresponding delivery note in the letterbox in the entrance hall.

At the end of your stay, the rolls are paid for in **cash** on the spot.

RESTAURANTS

On the slopes, you will find many nice and good restaurants. In busy periods, it's best to make reservations early on.

In the afternoon we like to eat at the Mooserwirt, Griabli (pizzas!), Sennhütte, Rodlalm in St Anton or the Hospitz or Thaya in St Christoph.

If you want to dine, elaborately think about the Verwallstube (Galzig) or the Himmeleck (Nasserein).

We also really enjoy going to Lech/Oberlech. In fine weather, be sure to make reservations on the terrace of the Mohnenfluh or the Rud-Alpe.

In the evening, you can find three nice restaurants within walking distance of our house:

- Pfeffermühle
- Gletscherblick
- Tenne

In St Anton, we recommend:



- Al Fuego (Spanish, grill)
- Sticky Fingers (fondue)
- Tannenhof (posh and expensive)
- Anthony's
- Niki's Weinbar

APRES-SKI

The Mooserwirt is known worldwide, a bit higher up you have the Sennhütte and Heustadl (both sometimes with live music) and the Crazy Kanguru or the Taps bar. At the base station of the Galzigbahn you'll also find Basecamp (crowded) or Underground (convivial).

On the main street, you have some more nice bars like Murrmel, Pub 37, Cuba bar and very cool wine bars. (Vinoteca, Niki's,...)

VILLAGE

St Anton is a large ski village, with nice restaurants, shops, hiking trails, etc. Discover its beautiful buildings and streets.

Happy to also drive to Lech (25-minute drive) where it is also wonderful skiing, hiking and shopping. (Free parking at the end of Lech - right side). You can also get there on skis via the slopes.

SKIPAS

You buy them at the valley stations of the Galzig-, Rendl- or Nassereinbahn.

SKIING

Austria's No. 1 ski resort! That's all we need to say: snow-sure, countless slopes and super-modern lifts.

In the morning, we love skiing on the Rendl - including a beautiful black run under the chairlift at the top, and a wonderful descent back between the trees into the village.

At the top of the Rendl you'll also find the Fun park, at your own risk....

Or just ski to St Christoph and eat at the Thaya (pulled pork!) or the Hospiz (check out the big terrace outside and the beautiful hut inside). Ski the slopes of Stuben and take the bus or the ski lift to Zürs where the Weisse Ring starts. Take it from us, you can't possibly ski all the slopes in one week.

You can ski as far as Oberlech and Warth. Take the lift back in Zürs to Stuben at 3.30pm at the latest: here you'll have the last chairlift at 4.20pm and then you'll descend to St Anton without any problems.



Worst case you take the free ski bus in Zürs or Stuben, so no panic.

Happy to also take the car up to Zürs (15 min) or Lech (25 min) itself for a while and then ski all day there.

In Zürs, there are two large free car parks along the route.

In Lech, it's best to continue to the end on the right where you can also park for free; take the Schlosskopfbahn and enjoy the beautiful scenery.

Also take the lift to Warth and discover beautiful ski boulevards here too.

After skiing in Lech, you can toboggan again from Oberlech (sledge costs 5 euros for the whole evening) and visit the shop Strolz, the most luxurious shop in the whole region.

SKISCHOOLS

There are several ski schools in St. Anton, which meet best at the Galzig.

The Ski School Arlberg (blue ski suit tenue) is the best known and especially suitable for group lessons: www.skischule-arlberg.com

In addition, you can rent or buy ski equipment and buy the latest ski fashion everywhere in all sports shops.

OFFPISTE

Nowhere are there more off-piste possibilities than in St. Anton/Lech. Just check the avalanche ratings (1 to 5)! Or book a ski instructor for a day. He will show you the improbable possibilities of the ski area. Please do not ski off-piste if you are not familiar with the snow conditions or there is a high avalanche danger level. By doing so, you not only put yourself in danger but also other skiers and the mountain rescue team!

TOBOGGANING

The toboggan run in St. Anton starts at the top station of the Nassereinbahn and leads back to the valley on the toboggan run, which is more than 4 kilometers long. At the valley station of the Nassereinbahn you can rent a toboggan in the sports stores.

HIKING

You can walk everywhere. The beautiful shopping street is also car-free!



We also like to hike start from Moose-Lodge in the direction of Pffeffermühle down the Timmlerweg. To the right of the MPreis, you can walk over the water via the bridge and then walk two kilometers to the center of St Anton. Take an aperitif in a wine bar here and then return via Nasserein and Chrystal-Spaces to Moose-Lodge: a nice walk of 4 km in total.

WELLNESS

Moose-Lodge has a brand-new sauna, usable all day! Also, enjoy our infrared cabin or dream away in our relaxation room.

If you want to go to a wellness center, in bad weather, for example, there is the Arlberg WellCom in the center of St. Anton or the Wellnesspark in Pettneu.

RELAXATION

Moose Lodge has a professional pool table and darts.

Please show respect for the beautiful equipment, we want to enjoy it for a long time.

CHECK-OUT

Generally, our apartments are rented from Saturday to Saturday. In some periods, other days are possible.

We ask you to check out before 9 o'clock. Only then can the apartment be cleaned to perfection for the next guests.

If you want to help the cleaning company, please leave all used towels and sheets at the front door of the flat.

Feel free to ski on the day of your departure. Drop your luggage in the garage or the lounge. We like to make the most of our holidays ourselves.

CHECK-IN

This is possible from 4 pm onwards. Any adjustments are best discussed on the spot.

COTS

We have 2 cots and two highchairs available. Feel free to ask and we will set them up for you.



Elevator

You have a spacious stairwell, but otherwise just take the lift, especially for luggage!

GARAGE

Your car is nice and dry in our garage. Get out and take the stairs or the lift and you're there.

LAUNDRY-BED LINEN

Each room is supplied with fresh bed linen and towels. There are also sauna towels and bathrobes provided. So, you don't need to bring anything yourself!

If you want fresh towels midweek, please put the used towels in the stairwell on Wednesday morning.

Feel free to use the washing machine and dryer. These can be found on the ground floor in the laundry room. Ideal for washing sauna towels or ski stockings, for example. Just bring some washing powder with you...

TRAVEL

You can take the plane to Innsbruck or Zurich and then take the train or taxi.

The train stops in the center of St Anton. Take a bus or taxi (5 min) to Moose-Lodge.

If you come by car from Germany, it's best to drive via Ulm/Bregenz. The navigation system sometimes sends you via the Fernpass but that's certainly not shorter or easier.

In Bregenz at the border crossing, it's best to stop to buy a vignette (10-day) and a pass for the Arlbergtunnel there and back. (All together EUR31.5)

You can avoid the tunnel by taking the mountain pass locally via Stuben but this is only recommended in good weather.

On exiting the Arlberg tunnel, keep right and follow St Anton. From here it is another 3 km to Moose-Lodge, just before the church of St Anton. Best take the Timblerweg (past the Pfeffermühle) uphill and then turn back 300 meters.

Beware of the many ski buses. They have the right of way everywhere.

Winter tires are usually sufficient, you don't have to climb a high mountain pass.

You operate the garage door from the inside with a push-button - it closes again automatically.

You enter the garage through the door next to the gate (general code).
